

THE ANSWER IS READY AND WAITING

*Some people are dubious about a God that is not limited by space or time, nor any natural laws. However, the working knowledge of this truth, offers us amazing possibilities. Can you imagine the benefit of knowing the future before it happens, likewise, knowing the thoughts and actions of your enemies and knowing how to access the power to change things that threaten or intimidate us. When we receive the Holy Spirit, we also receive access to the supernatural power that Jesus exercised. **JOH 8:58** Jesus said unto them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, **Before Abraham was, I am.** This is a very precise revelation that the power that potentially is able to work in us, is also not bound by space or time, or any natural boundaries whatsoever. Jesus is equally alive in the past as he is in the future... thus he is the perfect helper for every situation.*

God knows the beginning through to the end, of all natural time. **ISA 46:10** Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure: God is able to do the impossible, because he is Spiritual... not bound by any natural law.

Thus God knows what we need before we ask him. **MAT 6:7** But when ye pray, use not vain repetitions, as the heathen do: for they think that they shall be heard for their much speaking. Prayer is different when we have the spirit... God is not hindered by time or chance... so we can put our needs and fears before him regardless of what they are. We can talk to him in real time as a real person (not as a far off spiritual being), because he has the power to change our future... despite our past. **8 Be not ye therefore like unto them: for your Father knoweth what things ye have need of, before ye ask him.** He's had time to get the answer ready.

Every prayer is heard... every prayer opens the door to unlimited potential. **1JOH 5:13** These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God. **14** And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: **15** And if we know that he hear us, whatsoever we ask, we know that we have the petitions that we desired of him. Even David who didn't have the spirit knew this. **PSA 55:17** Evening, and morning, and at noon, will I pray, and cry aloud: and he shall hear my voice.

Why let doubt or fear undermine God's power that works in us? **MAT 14:31** And immediately Jesus stretched forth his hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt? Peter stepped out in faith but was soon overwhelmed by natural forces and thinking. Notice how Jesus stretched his hand out and protected him from harm... even though fear and doubt overtook him.

How our eyes get opened to the available blessing and truth. **2KIN 6:15** And when the servant of the man of God was risen early, and gone forth, behold, an host (enemy forces) compassed the city both with horses and chariots. And his servant said unto him, Alas, my master! how shall we do? **16** And he answered, Fear not: for they that be with us are more than they that be with them. Elisha never prayed for the situation to change... only that his servant could see the reality of the truth. The servant could not be persuaded by explanation or description alone... he actually had to see it himself. **17** And Elisha prayed, and said, LORD, I pray thee, open his eyes, that he may see. And the LORD opened the eyes of the young man; and he saw: and, behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire round about Elisha. Elisha prayed that the young man could see the reality and strength of their position. Only God can open our eyes when we are blind to spiritual realities, but it remains our choice whether we choose to look or not. No one can make us see, it's our option.

God has promised a similar solution for every difficulty that threatens us. **1COR 10:13** There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God is faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear it. If we sincerely pray and maintain our stand, God will reveal the solution, which has already been prepared before even one atom of the universe was in existence... 14 billion years ago at current estimates. It is the same with witnessing, healing, the use of the gifts, etc... it is already there, we only need to look up.

Jesus summarised what Elisha and David above, also knew to be true... dedicated and faithful prayer works. **MAT 6:33** But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you. This is the only way possible, to both see and acquire the blessings that God has already lined up for us. Anything less than sincere commitment will only lead to frustration, disappointment and in the longer term... total failure. If you have the power of the Holy Spirit, why not let it work for you?
