

ABSOLUTE PROOF

It is of great value to compare the signs, contained within the God given ministry of Moses, with the signs based gospel of Jesus Christ... Moses story is complete, while the Christian age is still underway. By comparing the two sign based ministries, we learn of the absolute proof being offered to God's people today.

Moses relied upon signs. EXO 3:2 And the angel of the LORD **appeared** unto him in a flame of fire out of the midst of a bush: and he looked, and, behold, the bush **burned with fire**, and the bush **was not consumed**.

God gave a rod to serve as a sign and source of power. EXO 7:10 And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh, and before his servants, and it became a serpent. **11** Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments. **12** For they cast down every man his rod, and they became serpents: but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods. *God's serpent ate up the false serpents... God's proof is that his power over rides all alternative options.*

Moses was also challenged, despite the miracles and directions ordained by God. ACT 7:35 This **Moses** whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did God send *to be* a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush. *People have always ignored miracles when it suits their agenda. This 'Christian' age is no different... many people choose feelings over substance.*

Spied out the promised land... too hard. NUM 13:30 And Caleb stilled the people before Moses, and said, Let us go up at once, and possess it; for we are well able to overcome it. **31** But the men that went up with him said, We be not able to go up against the people; for they *are* stronger than we. *Those of true faith identified with God's power to win the battle... their faith rested on God given proof. Blinded faith, destroyed all others!*

Despite most Israelites rejecting the plan of God, he chose a ministry of signs. Equally, our current gospel is built on the signs of God's choosing, not ours! Moses was called and saved by water and fire (bulrushes and burning bush... the parting sea and pillar of fire). The same theme continues even today (water baptism and the anointing Spirit). Moses lived 120 years... 120 people received the Holy Spirit at Pentecost... all speaking in tongues (Greek 'Dunamis: Godly power' 120 times in the New Testament). Sign upon sign upon sign.

Speaking in tongues is the universal sign that God offered, Jesus confirmed, Peter and Paul identified and the true church is still experiencing. **MAR 16:17** And these signs shall follow them that believe; ...they shall speak with new tongues; this is still happening worldwide. **Luke recorded it as... ACT 2:4** And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance. **Peter explained and directed... 38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. **Peter also stated that a sign based salvation, would only end at Christ's return... 39** For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, *even as many as the Lord our God shall call.* *Christian salvation is a sign based life & ministry; similar to Moses' ministry. Those who put personal belief ahead of God's signs under Moses, died... this age will end the same way. Similarly, beliefs that are built on powerless faith will fail.*

Speaking in tongues is the ultimate tool of this age... It is the sign of salvation, a spiritual language of prayer and a gift in the church... the evidence of God's choosing. 1COR 14:21 In the law it is written (Isa 28:11), **With men of other tongues and other lips will I speak unto this people; and yet for all that will they not hear me**, saith the Lord. *God reveals his chosen sign (Paul quotes Isaiah, where tongues is revealed 730bc), despite God's warnings; many are prophesied to reject both it and its followers, preferring powerless dogma!! Moses faced the same unbelief. 22* Wherefore **tongues are for a sign**, not to them that believe, but to **them that believe not**: but prophesying *serveth* not for them that believe not, but for them which believe. *This scriptural fact is included for good reason. God has a sign for those who doubt or disregard signs... tongues!!*

Jesus was asked for another sign... MAT 16:1 The Pharisees also with the Sadducees came, and **tempting** desired him that he would shew them a sign from heaven. **& 4** A wicked and adulterous generation seeketh after a sign; and there shall no sign be given unto it, but the sign of the prophet Jonas. And he left them, and departed. *His reply was not to their liking; everything he did was full of signs miracles and wonders, clearly identifiable to natural and spiritual observation... and the scriptures. They simply refused to accept the biblically backed signs and miracles. Their offence at God's chosen signs, doomed them to the same fate as those who doubted Moses. The signs of Pentecost are God's choice... absolute proof is still being offered.*
