

THE LAW OF THE UNIVERSE

*Newton's third law of motion is: For every action, there is an equal and opposite reaction. Many use the term 'Karma', to extend this principle beyond a law of physics and suggest it applies to all areas of life... those who do good or evil are rewarded accordingly. Far more importantly, the bible also reveals strong spiritual laws that are equally true in every area of human application. For those filled with the Holy Spirit there are amazing opportunities to change the direction and value of our lives, if we learn to use these laws wisely. God has always been the source of energy and life, but humanity prefers to avoid the conditions associated with real spiritual awareness and power. **Reality check...** we are not human beings choosing to have a spiritual experience; we are spiritual beings choosing much more than just our human experience.*

*This is the first of many sobering realities of God's laws. **EZE 18:4** Behold, all souls are mine; as the soul of the father, so also the soul of the son is mine: the soul that sinneth, it shall die. Avoiding the source of life and its laws only restricts opportunities... it doesn't actually remove the authority, nor does it avoid the consequences. God claims to be both creator and owner of all life, thus our choices lead to life or death.*

*Humanity has largely rejected God (life) and now faces the consequences (death). **DEU 30:19** I call heaven and earth to record this day against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing: therefore choose life, that both thou and thy seed may live: The reality of life and death are always before us, thus we all must choose between believing the true Gospel, with signs and evidence, or dying without remedy. Jesus Christ cancelled all sin by his death and resurrection (action and reaction), for those who obey His law... a natural action resulting in spiritual reaction, with many spiritual and natural benefits.*

*Salvation message. **ROM 6:23** For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. This is how the law of life works... **ACT 2:38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. Repentance from sin (action), leads to forgiveness through the infilling of the Holy Spirit (reaction). **ROM 8:2** For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death. Likewise, our houses survive storms etc., because the design is stronger than the forces opposing it. Similarly the Spirit in us is stronger than the forces, doubts and fears that may come against us.*

*The Holy Spirit gives us addition powers, which greatly multiply Newton's observed laws. **MAT 6:33** But seek ye first (action) the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you (reaction). Repeated again... **2COR 9:6** But this I say, He which soweth sparingly shall reap also sparingly; and he which soweth bountifully shall reap also bountifully. Then comes the following benefits...*

*& **10** Now he that ministereth seed to the sower both minister bread for your food, and multiply your seed sown (your actions bring about spiritually powered reactions), and increase the fruits of your righteousness;) 100 times example. **MAT 10:29** And he said unto them, Verily I say unto you, There is no man that hath left house, or parents, or brethren, or wife, or children, for the kingdom of God's sake (first action), **30** Who shall not receive manifold more in this present time, and in the world to come life everlasting (God's reaction). A seed has to die before it can multiply... that's the true application of seeking the Lord first.*

*Christianity is a lifestyle action, always starting with mercy and forgiveness. **LUK 6:36** Be ye therefore merciful, as your Father also is merciful. **37** Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven: Forgive and forgive. **38** Give, and it shall be given unto you; good measure, pressed down, and shaken together, and running over, shall men give into your bosom. For with the same measure that ye mete withal it shall be measured to you again.*

*Sacrifice is the first step towards multiple blessing (eg, Christ's sacrifice). **MAL 3:10** Bring ye all the tithes into the storehouse, that there may be meat in mine house, and prove me now herewith, saith the LORD of hosts (take the first step, give of your natural treasures, so God can give his treasures), if I will not open you the windows of heaven, and pour you out a blessing, that there shall not be room enough to receive it.*

*Self preservation and defence work on the same principle. **EPH 6:11** Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. God's power is stronger than the world's opposition.*

*Preach the Gospel... **MAR 16:15** And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. **ISA 55:11** So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void (every action will always provoke a reaction, this is God's way), but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it. The formula for salvation is based on an equal and opposite reaction to death. The law of the universe is open to God's blessing, just as He planned it.*
