

## THE 5 GREATEST QUESTIONS

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*It is no surprise that some of the toughest and most daunting questions that might get asked about God, the church and the future of humanity; are very clearly presented in the scriptures. The following questions and answers relate to the greatest challenges facing the human race today.*

**What shall we do?** *Jesus Christ was murdered because of jealousy, hatred and false accusations. **ACT 2:36** Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly, that God hath made that same Jesus, whom ye have crucified, both Lord and Christ. **37** Now when they heard *this*, they were pricked in their heart, and said unto Peter and to the rest of the apostles, Men *and* brethren, **what shall we do?** **38** Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost. **39** For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to all that are afar off, *even* as many as the Lord our God shall call. *God has provided a workable solution with signs and conclusive evidence... eternal life has always been the real target. Why would people avoid such strong evidence for the most urgent of all solutions to human suffering and death? Has anything changed today?**

**Which is the greatest commandment.** *Mocking God's people is often met with a mind changing solution. **MAT 22:35** Then one of them, *which* was a lawyer, asked *him* a question, tempting him, and saying, **36** Master, **which is the great commandment in the law?** **37** Jesus said unto him, Thou shalt love the Lord thy God with all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind. **38** This is the first and great commandment. **39** And the second *is* like unto it, Thou shalt love thy neighbour as thyself. **40** On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets. *This is the only effective summary, of self-sustaining living.**

**When did we see you hungry and thirsty?** *The greatest law comes with judgements. **MAT 25:34** Then shall the King say unto them on his right hand, Come, ye blessed of my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for you from the foundation of the world: **35** For I was an hungred, and ye gave me meat: I was thirsty, and ye gave me drink: I was a stranger, and ye took me in: **36** Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me. **37** Then shall the righteous answer him, saying, Lord, **when saw we thee** an hungred, and fed *thee?* or thirsty, and gave *thee* drink? **38** When saw we thee a stranger, and took *thee* in? or naked, and clothed *thee?* **39** Or when saw we thee sick, or in prison, and came unto thee? **40** And the King shall answer and say unto them, Verily I say unto you, Inasmuch as ye have done *it* unto one of the least of these my brethren, ye have done *it* unto me. *God demands that the whole of humanity should care for one another. This is so simple, yet so full of sustainable peace and happiness when understood and practiced.**

**Help me in my unbelief.** **MAR 9:23** Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things *are* possible to him that believeth. **24** And straightway the father of the child cried out, and said with tears, Lord, I believe; **help thou mine unbelief.** *The most pitiful cry for help you could ever hear... yet we can all identify with it. God also answers this same questions in many other scriptures. God has got us covered; all we need to do is ask.*

**ISA 40:29** He giveth power to the faint; and to *them that have* no might he increaseth strength.

**ROM 8:26** Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. *All we need to do is to make our application to God; then remain firm in that belief. It is not our job to change the universe, only to remain faithful and trusting in God's ways... regardless. Ongoing faith is a constant status of trust.*

**What manner of men ought we to be?** *A day unlike any other day is very near. **2PET 3:10** But the day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night; in the which the heavens shall pass away with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up. *Material possessions vanish; the body will vanish; all opposing thoughts about God will also vanish. The opportunity to save yourself and family will vanish. **11** Seeing then that all these things shall be dissolved, **what manner of persons ought ye to be** in all holy conversation and godliness, **12** Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat? **13** Nevertheless we, according to his promise, look for new heavens and a new earth, wherein dwelleth righteousness. *This is the greatest physical challenge the people of the earth will ever face. Probably the greatest question that could ever be asked to any person in any time frame... what type of person should you be??***

*It's simply amazing, that every major problem facing humanity has a simple solution. The scriptures consistently reveal God given signs that cannot be duplicated by any other method. The greatest question is still to be asked... Will you believe God and do what he asks?*
