

## FACT CHECKING THE GOSPEL

*The world is full of fake news and fake gospels. We can't always fact check the news, but we can always fact check the salvation gospel and its contents: by comparing the bible with the works God's doing with his people.*

**1COR 2:13** Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teacheth, but which the Holy Ghost teacheth; comparing spiritual things with spiritual. **The two major covenants are both backed with God given signs. Solomon dedicates the temple and God responded. 2CHR 6:42** O Lord God, turn not away the face of thine anointed: remember the mercies of David thy servant. **7:1** Now when Solomon had made an end of praying, the **fire came down from heaven**, and consumed the burnt offering and the sacrifices; and the glory of the Lord filled the house. **2** And the priests could not enter into the house of the Lord, because the glory of the Lord had filled the Lord's house. **Peter encourages the faithful to pray and God responds once again. ACT 2:3** And there appeared unto them **cloven tongues** (divided languages) like **as of fire**, and it sat upon each of them. **4** And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and began to speak with other tongues, as the **Spirit gave them utterance** (God's chosen sign).

*It was God himself who filled people with the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost... not the result of natural efforts, nor an item of church dogma.*

**Body is temple. 1 COR 6:19** What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? **20** For ye are bought with a price: **therefore** glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. *This is consistent with the words of Christ and O/T principles.*

*These words are built on the concept of having received the Holy Spirit with sign following... A God given experience that overrules fake and false Gospels.*

**These signs shall follow them who (truthfully and faithfully) believe. MAR 16:15** And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. **16** He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. **17** And these **signs shall follow them that believe**; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall **speak with new tongues**; **18** They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.

*The Holy Spirit itself becomes the fact checker of scriptural truths when it dwells within us... if we seek knowledge and wisdom and let it work.*

**The Holy Spirit will teach, comfort and bless. JOH 14:26** But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. **&JOH 15:26** But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me: **27** And ye also shall **bear witness** (offer proof), because ye have been with me from the beginning.

*The greatest enemies of God and the church are often those who claim to serve God and the people. Their response to the truth reveals whether they are fake or real.*

*Not everyone was happy with signs... many were in it for gain and/or the love of power (like Satan). Jesus offered signs, miracles and unlimited service and blessing to the people. Many who claimed to represent God, rather than rejoicing, felt threatened and had him killed... the way of this world (Satan was a murderer from the beginning).*

**JOH 8:44** Ye are of your father the devil, and the **lusts** of your father ye will *do* (to take control). He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him.

**The priests bribed the guards... and published fake news to cover their fake gospel... MAT 28:12** And when they were assembled with the elders, and had taken counsel, they gave large money unto the soldiers, **13** Saying, Say ye, His disciples came by night, and stole him away while we slept. **14** And if this come to the governor's ears, we will persuade him, and secure you. **15** So they took the money, and did as they were taught: and this saying is **commonly reported** among the Jews until this day. *It was still the fake, official narrative 40 years later, when Matthew was written. Nothing has changed today... how many are fact checking the bible as we are? Errors and false beliefs are repeated everywhere; but we can prove our faith with signs following.*

*It is sad to note (antichrist scriptures) that some of the worst offenders relating to fake gospels were originally in the church. 1JOH 2:19 They went out from us,,*

**Even Moses had signs following, but those in power didn't care for the people... they had another agenda. EXO 4:9** And it shall come to pass, if they will not believe also these **two signs**, neither hearken unto thy voice, that thou shalt take of the water of the river, and pour it upon the dry land: and the water which thou takest out of the river shall become blood upon the dry land. *Many people won't change despite the evidence.*

**HEB 10:16** This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them;

**We are given a clear warning. 2TIM 3:5** Having a form of godliness, but **denying** the power thereof (promoting the gifts of the spirit as optional): from such turn away. *Don't get caught out like them.*

**Fake news and fake doctrine. 1TIM 6:20** O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings (beliefs that don't support gospel power and facts), and oppositions of science ('established' knowledge) falsely so called: **21** Which some professing have erred concerning the faith. Grace be with thee. Amen. *There are many prophecies against fake gospels and their promoters and many solutions.*

**1COR 14:33** For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints.

*God is well aware that every church starts off with limited abilities and some errors. Thus he provides a pathway of growth and correction based on signs, miracles, and spiritual discernment (the spiritual common sense to sort out truths from errors... based on a working Gospel). We can always choose to believe whatever we want, but God will always back the truth in one way or another.*
